

## Dunny Derby Rules and Regulations

### **GENERAL CONDITIONS:**

Teams made up of 1 x Pushers, 1 x Pullers, may have 1 x Reserve (ALL TEAM MEMBERS TO BE NOMNATED PRIOR TO THE EVENT), **No person is allowed to be inside the dunny.**

- All team members to remain the same group for duration of competition
- All entrants must be 18 years + and are required to sign a waiver to participate.
- Closing date for nominations 4<sup>th</sup> April 2025.
- Entry Fee - \$25 per team to be paid with nominations
- Prize Money – Winner takes all

### **SPECIFICATIONS:**

- Dunny's to be soundly constructed of solid material and have 3 fully enclosed sides and a roof, (no front door). Structure must be solid and not destruct while racing. Base size to be a minimum of 800cm square and no more than 1200cm. Wall height to be a minimum of 1800cm.
- 2 wheels of any size may be used, you will be running on soft soil.
- **No sharp objects, glass** or protruding pieces are to be included in the racing outhouse.
- **No glass** to be used and outhouses must have a front entry only.
- Inside each must include a toilet seat, toilet paper holder.

### **RACE RULES:**

- Outhouses may have sponsorship advertising.
- Team name to be displayed on each side and back
- Oversized underpants must be worn on the Outside of each team members clothing. Underpants the responsibility of each team.
- All racing members must cross the finish line along with the dunny to finish. All stewards decisions are final.
- All Dunny's must be inspected by the steward 3pm Friday of the show, before being allowed to race. Failure to show up may result in disqualification.
- Teams will be required to race 100 metres for all heats. Running members to swap over at half way point.
- Winners from each heat will go into finals
- All races will have obstacles and are timed events.
